## SECTION V – REACTIVITY DATA

**Stability:** The product is stable  
**Incompatibility:** Highly reactive with organic materials, acids. Reactive with oxidizing agents.  
**Hazardous Decomposition Products:** None known at this time.

## SECTION VI – TOXICOLOGICAL PROPERTIES

**Routes of Entry:** Absorbed through skin. Eye contact. Ingestion.  
**Acute Effects on Humans:** Very hazardous in case of ingestion. Hazardous in case of skin contact (irritant, permeator), of eye contact (irritant), of inhalation. Corrosive to skin and eyes on contact. Liquid or spray mist may produce tissue damage particularly on mucous membranes of eyes, mouth and respiratory tract. Skin contact may produce burns. Inhalation of the spray mist may produce severe irritation of respiratory tract, characterized by coughing, choking, or shortness of breath. Severe over exposure can result in death. Can be fatal if inhaled or ingested.  
**Chronic Effects on Humans:** CARCINOGENIC: Not available.  
MUTAGENIC EFFECTS: Not available.  
TERATOGENIC EFFECTS: Not available.  
DEVELOPMENTAL TOXICITY: PROVEN (isopropyl alcohol)  
Repeated or prolonged contact with spray mist may produce chronic eye irritation and severe skin irritation. Repeated or prolonged exposure to spray mist may produce respiratory tract irritation leading to frequent attacks of bronchial infection. Repeated exposure to a highly toxic material may produce general deterioration of health by an accumulation in one or many human organs.

## SECTION VII – PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

**Gloves:** Seamless Neoprene.  
**Eye Protection:** Splash goggles.  
**Respiratory Protection:** Not normally required when used as directed.  
**Other Protective Equipment:** Suggested protective clothing may not be sufficient, consult a specialist BEFORE handling this product.  
**Engineering Controls:** General ventilation normally adequate. Ensure that eyewash stations and safety showers are proximal to the workstation location.  
**Leak and Spill Procedure:** Dilute with water and mop up, or absorb with an inert material and put the spilled material in an appropriate waste disposal. If necessary, Neutralize the residue with a dilute solution of acetic acid. Corrosive liquid. Stop leak if without risk. Absorb with DRY earth, sand or other non-combustible material. DO NOT get water inside container. DO NOT touch spilled material. Use water spray curtain to divert vapour drift. Prevent entry into sewers, basements or confined areas; dike if needed. Call for assistance on disposal. Neutralize the residue with a dilute solution of acetic acid. Be careful that the product is not present at a concentration level above TLV. Check TLV on the MSDS and with local authorities.  
**Waste Disposal:** Consult municipal, provincial, and federal laws.  
**Storage Requirements:** May corrode metallic surfaces. Store in a metallic or coated fibreboard drum using a strong polyethylene inner package. Keep container tightly closed. Keep from freezing. Keep out of reach of children.

## SECTION VIII – FIRST AID

**Eye:** Check for and remove any contact lenses. IMMEDIATELY flush eyes with running water for at least 15 minutes, keeping eyelids open. COLD water may be used. DO NOT use any eye ointment. Seek medical attention.  
**Skin:** If the chemical is on clothed portion of the body, remove the contaminated clothes as quickly as possible, protecting your own hands and body. Place the victim under a deluge shower. If the chemical touches the victim's exposed skin, such as the hands: gently and thoroughly wash the contaminated skin with running water and non-abrasive soap. Be particularly careful to clean folds, crevices, creases, and groin. COLD water may be used. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reusing.  
**Inhalation:** Allow the victim to rest in a well-ventilated area. Seek medical attention.  
**Ingestion:** DO NOT induce vomiting. Drink three glasses cold water. Examine the lips and mouth to ascertain whether the tissues are damaged, a possible indication that the toxic material was ingested; the absence of such signs, however, is not conclusive. Loosen tight clothing such as a collar, tie, belt, or waistband. If the victim is not breathing, perform mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. Seek immediate medical attention.
